Shampoo Girl/Guy:

Please follow me.

Please have a seat, lean back and relax.

Similar Expressions:

1. Make yourself comfortable: Make yourself at home.

2. Someone will be with you shortly: We'll be right with you.
3. This will take a moment: It'll be ready in a snap, it'll be ready right away.
4. We're all done: All done, voila.
5. Have a pleasant time: Have a pleasant experience, Hope you enjoy your experience, hope you have a great experience, hope you will be happy with our service.
6. Please follow me: Please come this way. This way please.
7. In a jiffy: Right away

Dialogue 1:
