Which restaurant will you eat at? – Which restaurant are you going to eat at?

What time will you get off work? – What time are you going to get off work?

해야하다

Subj + have to 동사 + (해야되는곳).

## Example:

I have to finish my homework.

I have to meet my sister.

I have to go home early.

# Basic Grammar 2:

~지만...but

I want to eat but it is too busy now.

I want to go out with my friends but I have to work tomorrow.

I want to eat but it's so busy.

#### Basic Grammar 3:

How about ~ 어때요? Suggestion 할때 이용하세요. How about Chinese (food)? How about 오십새주? How about 삼겹살?
Dialogue 1:
A: How are you? B: I'm good, how you doing? A: I'm doing alright. B: Did you eat breakfast? A: No, I didn't. B: I'm sorry to hear that. A: That's OK, I'll live. B: I'm going to get some food, do you want anything?
